This research explores the lived experience of Navy Hospital Corpsmen (medics) who have served in combat with U.S. Marine Corps units in Iraq and/or Afghanistan. It uses interpretive phenomenological analysis (IPA) to examine

both the lived experiences and the derived meaning of those experiences. The participants included eight, corpsmen that were screened for inclusion, using the PTSD Checklist-Military Version and the DSM-IV. The participants were asked a series of open-ended questions and were encouraged to discuss their traumatic experiences in combat, their past and current challenges with PTSD, and any meaning that they may have assigned to their experiences. The findings included an examination of the corpsmen's exposure to trauma and what they each interpreted as the most troubling experience they encountered. It explored their perceptions of having experiences, which were different and unique as compared to the Marines with whom they served. The research examined the participants' experiences in providing medical care for Marines, enemy combatants, and children. The findings included the corpsmen's affective, cognitive, and behavioral responses to the trauma they experienced. The participants shared the meaning they derived from their personal experiences, from the wars, and from the losses of life they witnessed. They shared their perceptions of how they have been changed by their trauma experiences. The findings reported the participants' experiences with the symptoms of PTSD as they are currently defined in the DSM-5. It also reported disagreements that participants voiced regarding current PTSD policies and protocols and their proposed recommendations for improving those areas. These findings give increased insight into the experiences and mindset of combat veterans in general and Navy hospital corpsmen, specifically. This greater understanding has direct implications for improving the therapeutic approaches used in PTSD treatment. It provides insight into the unconscious mental processes of medical personnel who have served in combat, which is consistent with depth
