By the next morning, only eleven men were left alive—but their desperate journey to freedom had just begun. *As Good as Dead* is one of the greatest escape stories of World War II, and one that few Americans know. The eleven survivors of the Palawan Massacre—some badly wounded and burned—spent weeks evading Japanese patrols.
