She was raised in a small family, who only had a donkey to carry their few possessions. They survived by working small ranches and living in the canyons where they could. Their foraging territory included Mission Valley, the backcountry of SD, Eastside canyons of the US and Mexico and all the way to the Gulf of California. Having no papers, she lost her husband and was forced to make terrible compromises to survive with her children. All this cultural disintegration has a bit of a happy ending when she gets some papers and stays on a reservation near Campo.
