Floret: Cut 6-by-2-inch strip of crepe paper; fold every 1/2 inch. Cut petals as shown. Wrap around end of wire. Secure with floral tape. **Triple Button:** Cut three 1-inch squares of crepe paper; make three wads of cotton the size of a pinky nail. Attach to wire as for #1.

When just cut, this bloom wilts in a matter of hours, but Cetti's variety is everlasting—and packs a tropical punch in just one bud. "I came up with the idea to dip red and orange crepe paper in bleach to erase some of the color, and kept experimenting with it in my basement," she says.

First cut the prefolded crepe paper to the height of the enlarged template. Lay template on top, aligning dotted edge of template with bottom edge of paper, and cut along the solid lines to create petals; do not cut all the way down the paper at the folds, but leave petals attached in a continuous strip. (The jagged top edge of carnation petals can be cut with pinking shears.)

Slide an eight-inch length of wire inside fold. Scrunch tissue paper along wire, creating a small pom-pom, the "stamen." Fold wire in half, and twist ends together to make a "stem." Cut pink floral crepe

paper into a wide rectangle, about four by 12 inches, with the paper grain running vertically.
