A direct object pronoun (un pronombre de objeto directo) replaces a direct object, which is a noun that directly receives the action of a verb in a sentence. Just like subject pronouns replace the subject noun in a sentence, direct object pronouns replace the direct object noun in a sentence, which can be a person, thing, noun phrase, or nominalized clause.
