Invisible Man is a milestone in American literature, a book that has continued to engage readers since its appearance in 1952. A first novel by an unknown writer, it remained on the bestseller list for sixteen weeks, won the National Book Award for fiction, and established Ralph Ellison as one of the key writers of the century. The nameless narrator of the novel

Ralph Ellison's classic 1952 novel *Invisible Man* is one of the most important and controversial novels in the American canon and remains widely read and studied.
